# INSPIRE: Investing in Community-Led Scholarship in Community Health Centers

In 2024, joint recipients of a Harvard & Legacy of Slavery reparative grant, partnered with IHE, health centers, and Harvard Medical School, to create INSPIRE - a pioneering program of self care, mentorship, and health systems policy advocacy to support descendants of American enslavement.



#### **INSPIRE for Nurses of Color**

In 2025, nurse descendants of slavery at <u>Codman</u>

<u>Square Health Center</u> and <u>Brockton Neighborhood</u>

<u>Health Center</u> will practice the Mandela Yoga

<u>intervention</u> combined with advocacy training.

They will build nurturing peer and mentor-scholar networks with Harvard-affiliated hospitals.

<u>Develop and disseminate a legal-informed toolkit</u> to re-set expectations for equitable research.

### **INSPIRE for Youth of Color**

In 2025, <u>high school student</u> descendants of slavery in Randolph, MA will practice the Mandela Yoga intervention, receive policy advocacy training, a paid health center internship, and a Harvard University-affiliate mentor.
